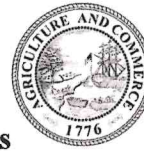

Minutes

The Baker County Board of Commissioners met on the above date with Tommy Rentz, Matt Bryan, and Connie Hobbs in attendance.

Chair Hobbs opened the meeting.

Chair Hobbs led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chair Hobbs delivered the invocation.

Chair Hobbs reported United Healthcare had declined to provide coverage for Baker County employees. Dover Rock Insurers, the county broker, had advised they were unable to secure a quote from any company due to lack of participation rate and suggested the county employees seek individual coverage and the county could provide a supplement. After discussion, Commissioner Rentz made a motion to provide up to a \$500.00 monthly supplement for full-time and acting full-time employees provided the employee provides verification of coverage and the premium amount and require the employee to notify the county of any changes in coverage within ten (10) days of the change. Commissioner Bryan seconded the motion. Commissioners Rentz, Bryan and Hobbs voted to approve the motion. Motion carried.

Chair Hobbs presented a request from Mitchell-Baker Family Connection for Baker County to continue serving as their fiscal agent for the upcoming fiscal year. Commissioner Bryan made a motion for Baker County to remain as the fiscal agent for Mitchell-Baker Family Connection. Commissioner Rentz seconded the motion. Commissioners Rentz, Bryan and Hobbs all voted in favor of the motion. Motion carried.

Commissioner Bryan made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Rentz seconded the motion. Commissioners Bryan, Rentz, and Hobbs all voted in favor of the motion. The meeting was adjourned.
